Goals and Expectations

The FDR Band program seeks to offer each student who is interested and eager to learn, an enjoyable learning experience centered around individualized musicianship and ensemble performance. A working understanding of basic tone production, rhythmic comprehension, fingerings, music vocabulary, dynamics, articulations, scales and key signatures, and rehearsal and performance of middle school literature reflect the FDR Tiger Band goals of achievement. Each member of the FDR Tiger Band program is expected to reflect positive behavior skills during ALL classes, rehearsals, and performances. Band membership at FDR is a PRIVILEGE (not a right), and should be treated as such.

Band Uniform

All students are required to purchase an FDR Band Polo Shirt. Order forms will be sent home during the first few weeks of school. Shirts are priced reasonably. If you have true economic difficulties that would prevent purchase of the shirt please contact Mr. Gerhart.

Boys – **black** dress pants (no jeans), FDR band shirt, dark shoes.

Girls –long black skirt or dress pants (no jeans), FDR band shirt, dark shoes.

*Please make every effort to avoid wearing jeans and sneakers. They are not appropriate concert attire.

Materials

All students are required to have the following materials for every class:

- Your Instrument
- Your band folder (provided by school).
- All music with your name written in the upper left hand corner.
- A pencil.

Student Responsibilities

1. Be on time for all classes, rehearsals, and performances. Class begins when the director steps on the podium (about 3 min after the bell). You are late if you are not prepared.
2. Be prepared for class with all materials.
3. Always show respect for the podium by being very quiet and attentive for whoever is instructing from it.
4. Never handle another person's instrument. Only percussionists are to touch the percussion equipment.
5. Only ask for hall passes at the appropriate time in the appropriate manner. (during "down time" using correct hand signal)
6. Represent the band in a positive way when participating in organized activities.

Consequences include: loss of class participation grade, lunch detentions, office referral, parent conference.

Grades

Formative - 35%

Participation/preparation (20 points daily)

You will be given a daily grade for participation and preparation. Everyone starts the class with 20 points. Deductions occur as follows:

- Unprepared – Materials (book, sheet music, pencil) – 5 pts
- Unprepared – Instrument –10 pts
- Not seated and ready to play when rehearsal begins – 5 pts
- Not actively participating in class – up to 20 pts

Summative - 65%

Students will be required to:

- **Participate in all performances.**
 - o Come prepared to perform with all necessary equipment and music.
 - o Wear the appropriate attire.
- * Excused absences will only be approved with a parent note. Once an absence is excused, a make-up assignment will be give to the band member.
- **Perform Benchmark tests**
 - o complete all assigned benchmark tests
 - submitted through the Music First Application.
 - live class performance for those not purchasing Music First.
 - o graded on the BTSD performance rubric
